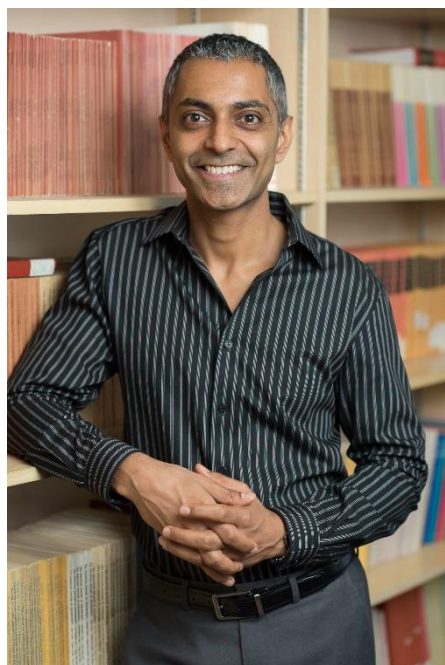

Gay neighbourhoods, like the Castro in San Francisco, Chelsea in New York, and Davie Village in Vancouver, have long provided sexual minorities with safe havens in an often unsafe world. But as our society integrates gays and lesbians into the mainstream, are “gaybourhoods” destined to disappear? In this talk, Professor Ghaziani will explore how societal acceptance of sexual minorities affects their geographic expressions and how those, in turn, are creating subtle new forms of sexual inequality.
