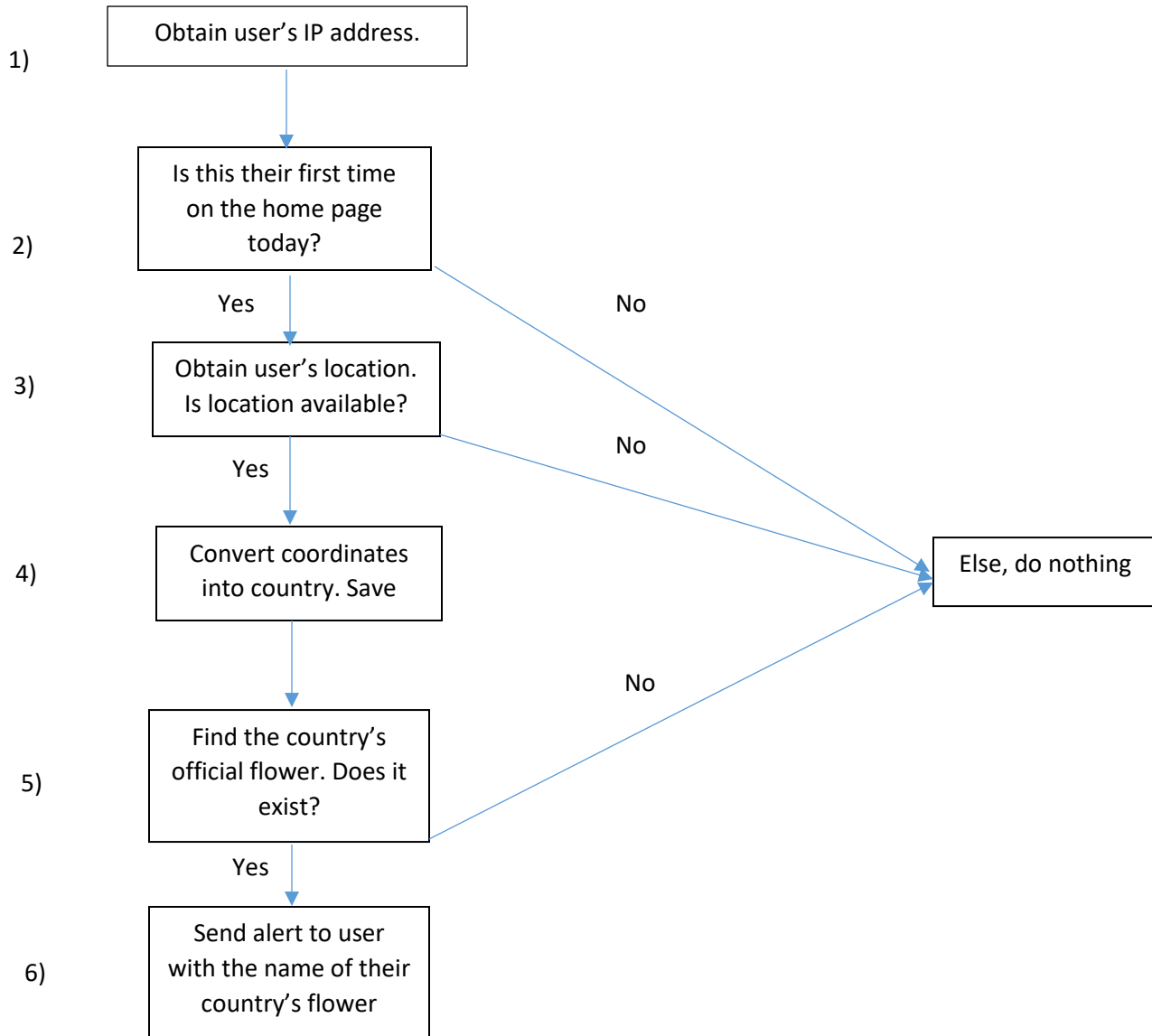


COMP266 Unit 5 – JavaScript Site Design

Design for a pop-up alert that informs user of their country's official flower

This is what happens when the user goes to the home page.



More detailed design:

- 1) Obtain user's IP address
- 2) Detect if that user has already been to the home page on that day (I don't want the alert to come up more than once per day for the same user)
- 3) Get user's country of origin using geolocation API (`var userCountry`) using `function getLocation` and return the value

- 4) If location is available, use `function getCountry` to convert coordinates into the name of the country, using Google Maps Reverse Geocoding and return this value. Save this value so that I can access it and see website metrics in order to tailor my content.
- 5) Use `function getFlower` that returns name & picture of official plant (`var flower`), `else` nothing happens (no pop-up). In the function `getFlower`, use a `switch` statement that lists the countries and their official flowers then returns it. Ensure to include a default in case the user's country is not on the list. If default, do not display alert
- 6) Pop-up an alert on user's screen that says 'Your country's official flower is the ' + flower + ' Flower!' with the plant picture beside the text using JavaScript `alert command`
